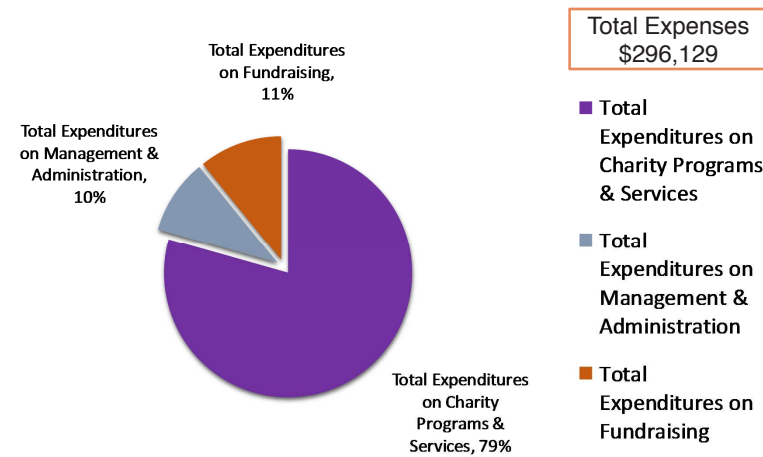

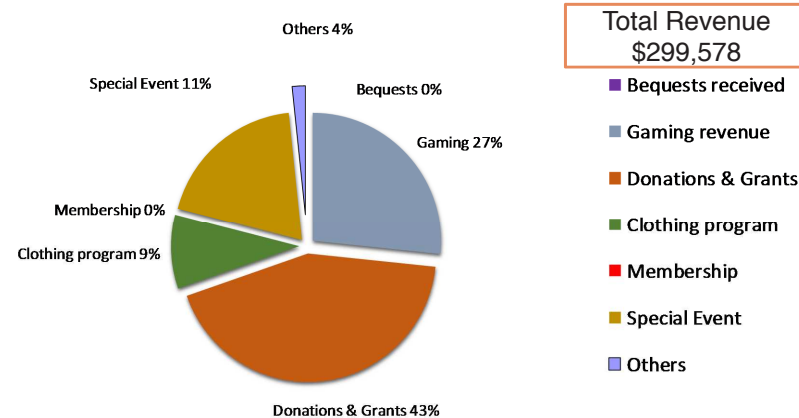

- September fundraising and wellness activity – we had 206 participants and raised about \$25,000
- Scotiabank Charity Challenge Half Marathon & 5k walk, run or wheel – 27 participants raised \$10,008 for CPABC
- We hosted our first ever Gala – we had 134 guests and raised about \$27,000
- We were honoured to be one of the beneficiaries of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) 20th Golf tournament – \$2,500 was raised
- Dance Without Limits – 960 hours of dance classes delivered in Vancouver and Surrey
- Yoga for Youth with Disabilities – 960 hours of yoga in Vancouver and Victoria
- Campership program – granted \$5,000 in camp subsidies to 14 children, youth and adults
- Tanabe Bursary Program – granted \$10,000 in bursaries to 11 talented students this year
- “Life Without Limits” connection series – one with 22 attendees
- Pre-Employment Training program – 8 participants with over 300 hours of workshops and practicum experiences
- Healthy Eating, Healthy Life (formerly community kitchen) – 10 sessions with a total of 150 participants
- Legal Workshops – 12 workshops with a total of 152 participants
- Accessing CSIL (Choices in Supports for Independent Living) – 10 workshops with a total of 300 attending
- We received over 600 inquiries from around British Columbia about living with cerebral palsy
- Volunteers assisted a variety of supports – 1,100 volunteer hours
- First face-to-face Advisory Committee meeting happened in January 2015 to discuss better understanding of the needs of people living with cerebral palsy
