Letter from Executive Director

2019-2020 has been a most interesting year. Our focus has been on rebuilding, repurposing, rebranding, and reconnecting. I am so proud that we have been able to rebuild a vibrant board with representation from various areas of our Province. We also created a Resource Development Committee to help us as we devise and implement a long lasting resource development strategy. We focused on bringing people together and started member gatherings which are a huge success. We also focused on reconnecting with not just members, but with our corporate and government friends too.

This was our investment year and the returns are starting to show. 
Family Day Event
